
Questions and Answers:

- 1. What are the dimensions needed for the rolls of 6- to 8-gallon DCBs to fit into the EcoSafe-MultiRes dispenser (as highlighted in Picture 1 in Attachment B; Section 4.8)?
 - A1. The dimensions of the rolls of bags that are currently inserted into the EcoSafe MultiRes dispenser are provided below. This is to assist vendors in determining the component of their proposal regarding providing special rolls of DCBs that will be distributed in these dispensers at county drop-off sites.

Type of dimension	Size
Diameter of full roll of bags	not to exceed 6 3/8"
Width of full roll*	not to exceed 5"
*include width of center tube, if included and/or if the tube	
protrudes from sides of the bag roll	
Diameter of center hole in roll	no smaller than 1"

The following diagram has been provided to further describe the size requirements for these rolls. Please note that the diagram is **<u>not</u>** to scale.

2. Will proposers have access to the results from R&E's performance testing?

A2. Data will be available in accordance with the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 13

3. Is the pricing fixed for one year or for the full contract?

A3. Pricing terms will be negotiated as described in Section 1.5, Section 5 and Attachment E (Price Worksheet) of the RFP. Vendors should submit requested payment terms in their proposal.

4. Are gusseted bags okay?

A4. Gusseted DCBs are acceptable as long as the bags meet all other specified requirements

5. Please provide exact address of the distributor in Minnesota.

A5. The exact address is not yet available as contracts are still being negotiated with a potential distributor. The distributor will be located in the Twin Cities metropolitan area of Minnesota.

6. Can a vendor offer you 2 sets of samples and their related reports in their proposal?

A6. Yes. The vendor should provide the required number of samples, described in section 2.7 of the RFP, for each type and size of bag proposed.
