EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Amended and Restated Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) of the Partnership on Waste and Energy (Partnership) provides the following direction on an annual budget and contributions by the Ramsey/Washington Recycling & Energy Board and Hennepin County ("Parties"):

- 5.2.4. The Governing Board shall develop and approve an annual budget (for the calendar year January 1 to December 31) at its first official meeting, and at a fall meeting in subsequent years.
- 5.2.4.1. The budget shall specify contributions by the Parties, which shall be allocated in equal parts to the Parties.
- 5.2.4.2. The Parties shall make their contributions to the Administrative Agent by February 28th of each year.

At the September 26, 2024, Partnership Board meeting, board members reviewed and discussed a draft 2025 budget prepared by staff. Staff made minor revisions to the budget based on this discussion and revised projections for 2025 programs and needs.

At the November 14, 2024, meeting, staff will present the 2025 budget for approval.

Authorize the Partnership on Waste and Energy (Partnership) lead staff to execute an amendment to the agreement with Capitol Hill Associates, Inc. that will increase the funds available to \$91,000 for the period of January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025, to a contract maximum not to exceed \$244,000, and allow additional work associated with waste lobbying services to be performed, upon approval as to form by the county attorney.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Capitol Hill Associates, Inc. (CHA) has been performing lobbying services for the Partnership since 2018. The most recent contract began January 1, 2023, when CHA won the award through a competitive solicitation process. Since that time, Partnership lead staff have identified a need for enhanced services to develop, provide and pursue strategies to maintain statutes and laws key to advancing Partnership interests, such as the Packaging Waste and Cost Reduction Act, in coordination with policy staff. Performing these additional services will require additional time and resources, requiring additional funds to be added to the contract.

WHEREAS, The Amended and Restated Joint Powers Agreement (Joint Powers Agreement) of the Partnership on Waste and Energy (Partnership) between Ramsey/Washington Recycling & Energy (R&E) and Hennepin County (individually identified as "Party" or jointly as "Parties") dated March 27, 2018, specifies that the Governing Board may negotiate, enter and enforce contracts necessary to accomplish the purposes set forth in the JPA; and

WHEREAS, The JPA identifies R&E as the Administrative Agent for the Partnership, and that its procurement guidelines will be used for Partnership procurement; and

WHEREAS, The JPA further charges the Governing Board to develop a legislative and policy platform, and to select the contract lobbyists for waste management and energy; and

WHEREAS, The Partnership has entered into an agreement with Capitol Hill Associates, Inc. to perform waste lobbying services on behalf of the Partnership; and

WHEREAS, Partnership lead staff have identified additional needs beyond the initial scope of the agreement, including developing, providing and pursuing strategies to maintain statutes and laws key to advancing Partnership interests, such as the Packaging Waste and Cost Reduction Act, in coordination with policy staff; and

WHEREAS, Performing these additional services will require additional time and resources, requiring additional funds to be added to the contract; and

WHEREAS, Partnership lead staff have reviewed the additional costs and determined them to be reasonable for the work being requested of Capitol Hill Associates, Inc. and recommend Board approval to increase the funds available under the contract to perform the additional work. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, The Governing Board hereby authorizes Partnership lead staff to execute an amendment to the agreement with Capitol Hill Associates, Inc. that will increase the funds available to \$91,000 for the period of January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025, to a contract maximum not to exceed of \$244,000, and allow additional waste lobbying services to be performed, upon approval as to form by the county attorney.

1. Modifications to Scope of Services

2. Pricing Adjustments

The funds available under this agreement for the period of January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 are increased to \$91,000. This amount will be distributed as outlined in Section 2 of the Agreement.

Except as addressed herein, the terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.


